NOTICE OF DEADLINE TO FILE FOR CANDIDACY

The Louisiana Assembly, being lawfully in Session and operating under **American Common Law**, hereby gives **Public Notice** that nominations and declarations of candidacy are now being accepted for all open public offices within the Louisiana Assembly. These offices are to be filled in the upcoming **February 17, 2026 Election**.

All qualified Assembly members are invited to step forward and serve their People in the spirit of self-governance and public duty.

Deadline to File for Office:

All candidate filings must be received no later than Date, January 17, 2026 at 12:00 PM (Central Time).

Election Day will be held on February 17, 2026 at 6:00 P.M. via online conference call. Link for the call is listed on the Assembly Website at www.thelouisianaassembly.com

No filings will be accepted after the deadline.

To file, candidates must submit the proper paperwork which can be obtained by contacting the State Coordinator (Contact information listed below) and meet the eligibility requirements as outlined in this Public Notice and consistent with American Common Law.

Candidate Requirements:

To be eligible to run for public office, you must:

- Be 21 years of age or older
- Be domiciled on the land and soil of Louisiana
- Be recorded as an American State National or State Citizen (status corrected)
- Be a current and active member of the Louisiana Assembly in good standing
- Be willing to uphold and serve under the principles of American Common Law

All candidates must be acting in their **unincorporated** capacity, not as U.S. citizens or legal persons.
